



Lightning Policy

When there is inclement weather, Pro Shop Staff use UBIMET to monitor lightning strikes.

A notification will alert Pro Shop Staff when there is a strike within 10kms.

Pro Shop Staff will follow the following procedure.

If there is a lightning strike within 10kms, Pro Shop Staff will sound the siren 3 times to suspend play, this will be repeated three times.

All golfers on the course, driving range & practice areas must return to the Clubhouse.

When the last lightning strike within the 10kms radius is more than 30 mins prior, the decision to resume play made be made.

Pro Shop Staff will sound the siren 1 time to resume play and players may return to the course to finish their round.

If players do not wish to return to the course to finish their competition round, they may notify Pro Shop Staff & submit their partial card for handicapping to receive a 'No Score – Approved'.

We will not penalise players for not returning to the course following suspension of play due to dangerous conditions.

Note: If a player decides not to notify Pro Shop Staff they will receive a 'No Score – Not Approved'.
