Conditions of Play

The Event:

The Cairns Junior Open will be played over two days, Monday 29th June 2025 & Tuesday 30th June 2026. The 18, 13 & 9 hole events are played over both days. The 9-hole Modified, 6 hole Modified & 3 hole Modified are only played on Tuesday the 30th June. All events are Stroke events. Nominations close via email to golfmanager@cairnsclub.com.au on Monday 22nd June at 7:00pm.

Players:

All participants in the 18-hole division MUST have a registered GA handicap. All other participants must have a junior club handicap issued by their home club. All juniors must be a financial member of a golf club to compete.

Fees:

Nomination fees must be paid prior to your start time.

Divisions:

The following Division will be played:

- 18 Hole Juniors with a GA Handicap
- 13 Hole Juniors with a Club Handicap
- 9 Hole Juniors with Club Handicap
- 9 Hole Modified Junior with Club Handicap
- 6 Hole Modified Juniors with Club Handicap
- 3 Hole Modified Juniors with Club Handicap.

Depending on numbers in each division, the Boys and Girls could possibly be combined.

Prizes:

Prizes will be awarded for both boys and girls in each division for the following:

- Gross Winner and Runner Up, and
- Net Winner and Runner Up.

Players can only win one major prize. Nearest to the Pin and Longest drives are not considered major prizes.

Rules:

The Rules of Golf as published by R & A Rules Limited together with Local Rules as issued by the Tournament Committee will apply.

Tournament Committee:

The Tournament Committee shall have the sole management and control of the tournament with full power at any time, to alter or vary any of the conditions.

Handicaps:

18 Hole players must indicate their Golflink number at time of entry. 13 Hole, 9 Hole, 9 Hole Modified, 6 Hole Modified and 3 Hole Modified Juniors are to produce evidence of their handicap to the tournament coordinator at the time of registration.

This event uses handicap guidelines as displayed in the FNQ Junior Handbook.

- 18 Holes Boys & Girls as calculated by Golf link
- 13 Hole Boys Minimum: 14.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 13 Holes Girls Minimum: 17.4 / Maximum: 45.4
- 9 Holes Boys Minimum: 10.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 9 Hole Girls Minimum: 12.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 9 Holes Modified Boys Minimum: 12.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 9 Holes Modified Girls Minimum: 14.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 6 Hole Modified Boys Minimum: 12.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 6 Hole Modified Girls Minimum: 14.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 3 Hole Modified Boys Minimum: 10.4 / Maximum: 36.4
- 3 Hole Modified Girls Minimum: 12.4 / Maximum: 36.4

When a junior's player reaches their minimum handicap requirement for their division, they can remain in that division and their handicap will still continue to be reduced or increased accordingly but they will no longer be eligible for the Gross Prizes. Players with handicaps below the minimum will be only eligible for Nett Prizes, NTP's and Long Drives.

Tees:

- 18, 13 & 9 Hole Boys – Black.
- 18, 13 & 9 Hole Girls – White.
- All Modified Players from the CGC Modified Tees.

Bag Pushers:

Players in the 3 Hole Modified Division, 6 Hole Modified Division, 9 Hole Modified Division and 9 Hole Division have the option to use a "Bag Pusher" to help them get around the course.

Bag Pushers ARE NOT CADDIES and are encouraged to assist each golfer in the group with pace of play, scoring and general golf etiquette.

Bag Pushers / Caddies are NOT allowed for players in 13 Hole and 18 Hole Junior Divisions.

Bag pushers are not permitted to do the following:

- Bag Pushers are not permitted to coach the players during the round.
- Bag Pushers are not permitted to tee the ball up or take a preferred lie for the players.
- Bag Pushers are not permitted to stand behind the players during a pre-shot routine or line up of shots.
- Bag Pushers are not permitted to read or line up putts for the player when on the green.

To assist with pace of play:

- Bag Pushers are permitted to act as additional spotters and help search for lost balls.
- Bag Pushers are permitted to rake bunkers.
- Bag Pushers are permitted on the green to take the flag out & identify player order.

Any Bag Pusher found to be crossing these clearly defined guidelines above will be given one official warning before being asked to leave the course. Key roles for Bag Pushers are:

- Be a good example to all junior golfers.
- Be courteous to all players, volunteers, tournament officials and spectators.
- Maintain pace of play and work to keep the group in position on the golf course.
- Avoid coaching your player and encourage ready golf.
- Assist the other caddies to make a good experience for all.
- Rake bunkers, repair divots and other actions to preserve or improve the condition of the golf course.

Draw & Starting times:

A draw for each day's play will be published. Players must start at the time and in the order arranged. The Tournament Committee has the option to change the draw at any time.

Players must arrive at his/her starting point ready to play within 10 minutes of his/her tee time.

Scoring:

At the conclusion of each round all players must immediately report to the scoring table. PLAYERS ONLY are allowed into the scoring area. If scoring officials need assistance from any caddies or spectators they will be advise, otherwise only players will interact with scoring officials.

Protests:

Protests or disputes must be lodged in writing with the Championship Committee no later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the players round on each day.

Ties:

Sudden death playoffs will be held only in the event of a tie for first place in the 18-hole Gross event. All other ties will be decided by the Australian Count Back System.

Spectators:

Spectators may not communicate with players in any manner at any time during their competition round. Spectators are always subject to the rules of the golf. Use of carts by spectators will be at the discretion of golf course management. If carts are allowed, they must stay on the cart path. NO PLAYER may ride in a cart at any time during the tournament. Spectators are required to turn mobile phones and electronic devices OFF when entering the golf course.

Spectators should NEVER touch a ball in play.

Mobile phones:

All mobile phones must be turned off.

The use of mobile phones by players, caddies and spectators is strictly prohibited in the precinct of the golf course, unless an extreme emergency occurs, or if required to contact a rule official. Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disqualification.

Distance measuring devices:

18 Hole and 13 Hole players may obtain distance information by using a device to measure distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g., gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3. Penalty for breach is 2 strokes for a first offence and for subsequent offences, disqualification. Juniors in 9 Hole, 9 Hole Modified, 6 Hole Modified & 3 Hole Modified divisions are not allowed to use measuring devices.

Motorised vehicles:

During any round of the Tournament competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle unless authorised by a member of the Tournament Committee. Penalty – 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred, maximum penalty per round – 4 strokes.

Competitors equipment is not permitted on motorised vehicles during the tournament. Penalty for breach is 2 strokes for each hole at which the breach occurred.

Dress code:

All participants must wear tournament appropriate golf clothing. The final decision on inappropriate dress will be with the Tournament Director.

Pace of play:

The Royal and Ancient rules for pace of play are in force and players are subject to penalty if they fall behind. Remember to keep up with the group in front of you not in front of the group behind. Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced.
